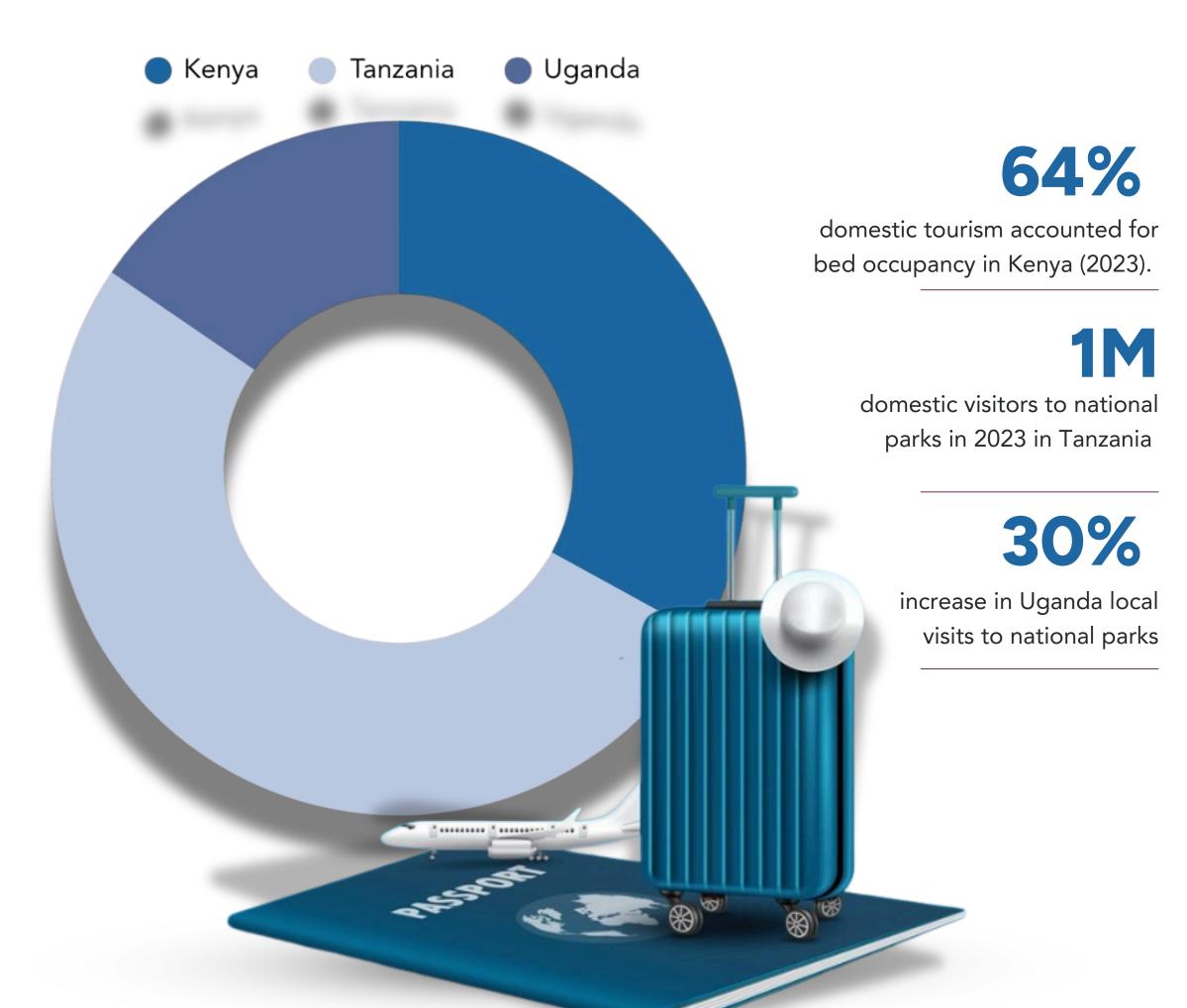
East Africa's Hospitality: Driven by Local Demand

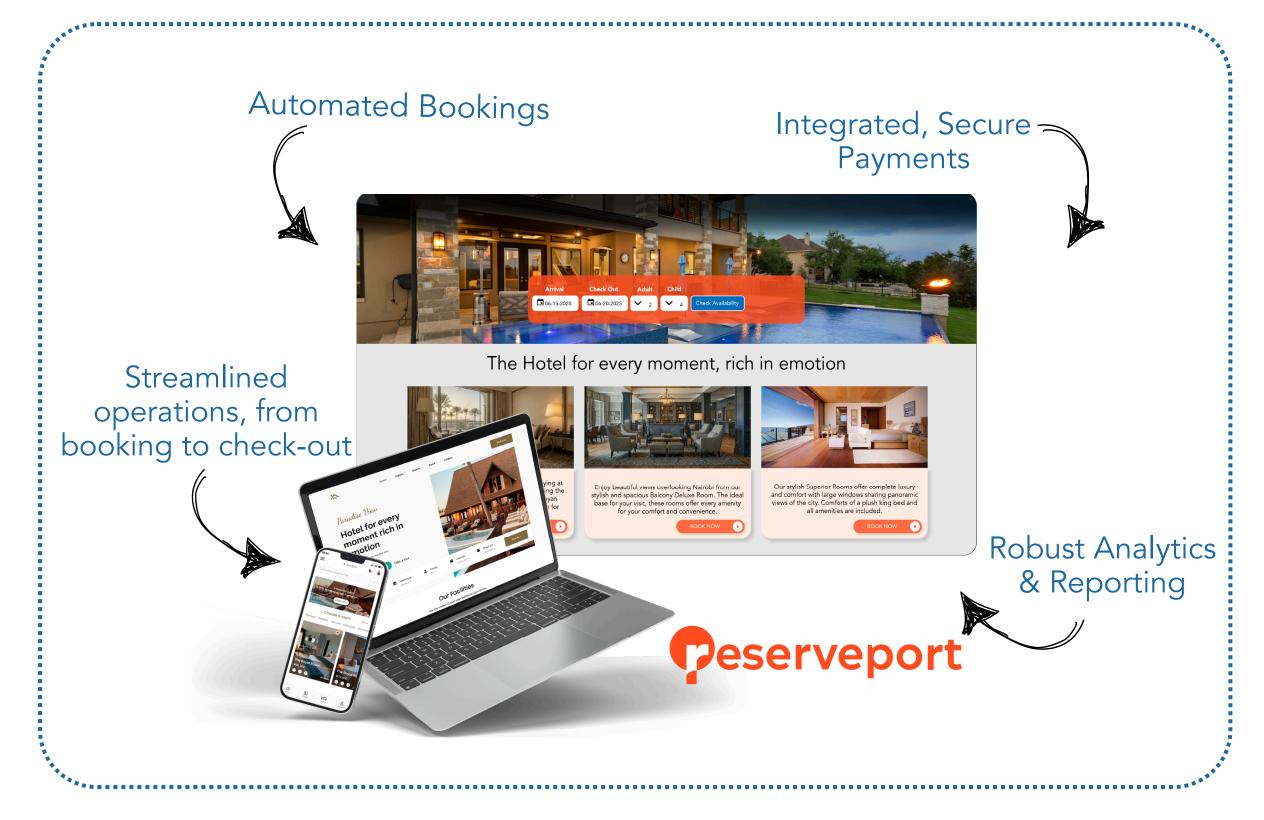
